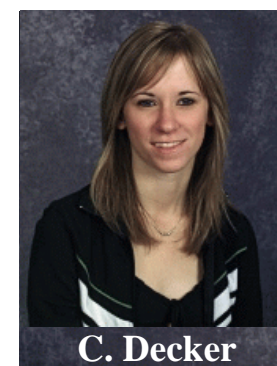

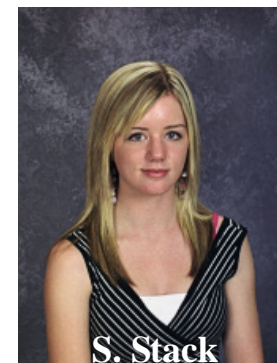

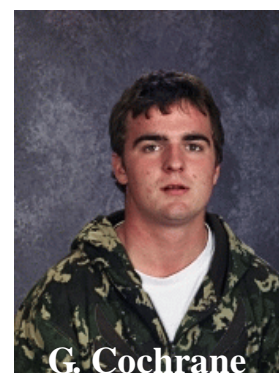
WORK PLACEMENT LEARNING OPTIONS
